## 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Family Responsibilities

The Township of East Brunswick, along with the school district, requires that we employ Site Safety monitors at all of our facilities. We negotiated the right to use parents, instead of paid employees.

The role of the site safety volunteer is to monitor what is happening off of the Basketball court, while the coach's responsibility is to instruct players on the court. We feel that since we use so many facilities and most for only a few hours at a time, it would not be cost effective to hire people to fill these roles. We could be playing in five different schools for only two hours in an evening, so it would be difficult to find five people to do the job.

In order to fulfill our contractual obligation to the Township, **ALL** families that participate in this program will serve in the roll of a site safety monitor. In order to insure the safety of our children, every family will serve in this role probably twice during the season. Each team will have a Team Parent who will organize safety volunteer schedules.

### **The duties of the Site Safety Monitor are:**

Keep everyone off the stages and equipment in the gyms. Nobody will be permitted to wander on the stage, use any of the toys or gym equipment, and use anything else that is the property of the schools, or **EAT or DRINK** anywhere inside the schools.

We understand that this will be a difficult task, so we also place this responsibility on the parents to monitor their own children. If parents are not cooperative with this policy, FBBA should be notified at once so we can address the issue with the families who violate this policy. We have received phone calls from the schools in the past and they insist that they will no longer waiver on this issue.

Keep all siblings out of the hallways. We have been given use of the gyms, water fountains, and bathrooms only. No playing in the hallways.

**Parking only in designated spots. If anyone parks illegally, you run the risk of having your Vehicle towed. Please do not jeopardize the future of the program by not following these rules. We will be held accountable to the Township & School system for enforcing them.**

### **Conduct and Participant Obligation:**

Program participants who fail to observe these Rules of Operation and Conduct governing this program may be subject to expulsion. A child should never be left alone at a program site until the **coach** arrives to accept responsibility for that participant. **It is the obligation of the parent or guardian to be keenly aware of the program's schedule and times. If you or your designated person does not pick up your child promptly, you risk expulsion from the league.**
