



EMERGENCY MEDICAL PROCEDURES

Guidelines to follow when players sustain an injury that requires emergency medical attention

Designated roles of Coaches, Game Coordinators, and Directors are as follows:

1. Attend to the injured player, identify injury, and control scene
2. Call 911
3. Call parent or person listed as a backup in case parent cannot be contacted
4. Call an FBBA Officer or Director if one is not present at the gym
5. Arrange to have someone meet emergency personnel and escort them to the injured player
6. Accompany player to the hospital if emergency personnel insist that the child MUST be transported, and the parent or designated backup has not yet arrived
7. Ensure that there is another coach on the court to tend to the other players
8. Complete the Accident Form and submit to the league
