Registration Packet 2010/2011

- **Registering** your child - complete pages [4 & 5](#) in their entirety
- **Volunteering** - complete pages [6 and/or 7](#)
- **Medical Release Forms** - must be turned into your Coach, not at Registration
- **Coaches** – need to be Rutgers Certified and Kid Safe approved prior to the start of the season, and attend PCA coaches workshop
- **Parents** – must attend PCA Parents Workshop
- **Work Bonds** – as outlined in Registration Guidelines

The Basketball Courts available to us, as well as the number of VOLUNTEERS that sign up will determine the size of each program.

*Fast Break Basketball does not discriminate against anyone due to race, color, religion or sex. We welcome any interested players in applying for the league.

Registration Guidelines:

Due to the fact that Fast Break Basketball has limited court space available to us, we have instituted a policy for bringing extra applications to the in-person registration.

You will only be permitted to bring the applications for YOUR CHILDREN and those of ONE ADDITIONAL FAMILY. All applications MUST BE COMPLETED PRIOR to standing on line.

Any additional applications will be placed in a box and processed with all the mailed in applications after the in-person registration. We will not permit someone to bring extra applications and ask people on line to hand them in. We believe that it is unfair to have someone who shows up for registration closed out of a position because someone else brought many extra applications.

Registration Information:

We anticipate being able to accommodate approximately 1200 children for the 2010/2011 season. We will once again be a co-educational program, as well as girls only in select grades, Travel, AAU and Buddy Ball. We will run programs serving 2nd thru 12th grades. **In order to run these programs, it is imperative that we get enough volunteers to fully staff each program. If we do not get enough volunteers or court space we reserve the right to limit enrollment in any program and refund registration fees** (please refer to coach/volunteer sign up sheet, pages 5 and 6).

We will hold an in-person registration on **Saturday, June 5th from 8:00am-10:00am at Hammarskjold Middle School in the cafeteria**. We also will advertise the date on Channel 3, as well as the Sentinel. You can also refer to our message center or web page (see methods of communication section of this packet). Registration is on a first-come first-serve basis. If history is any indication, we usually fill our programs within the first 1-hour of registration.

We will accept registration forms by mail that are post marked June 6th or later. These mailed applications will be processed for any remaining slots available after the in-person registration is completed. Prior postmarks will be returned.

Positive Coaching Alliance (PCA):

Fast Break Basketball has instituted workshops in conjunction with Positive Coaching Alliance (PCA). PCA, works with **organizational leaders, coaches and parents** to more effectively teach young athletes not only how to win, but also how to learn about teamwork, discipline, respect and goal-setting through their sports experience, and teach players positive character traits that will help them be successful in life.

FBBA recognizes the tremendous potential sports participation offers for today's youth and is working to realize that potential by fostering a positive club culture to support the organizations principles - promoting good sportsmanship, the value of hard work, respect of teammates and coaches, and confidence in oneself.

New Cost Structure of the program:

For the 2010/2011 season, the cost of participating will be as follows:

- 2nd – 4th Grade Programs - \$110.00 per child for all East Brunswick residents
- 5th – 12th Grade Programs - \$120.00 per child for all East Brunswick residents
- Buddy Ball - \$40.00 per child (this program is for children with special needs)
- Travel - approximately \$400 (including the recreation fees)
- AAU – season runs from April to June, costs to be determined, tryouts at a later date
- All non-East Brunswick residents will be charged \$15.00 per player in addition to the above rates.
- **WORK BOND - \$50.00 per family which will be refunded after attending the Parent PCA Workshop, and/or Coaches PCA Workshop (whichever is applicable).**
- **Separate checks must be submitted for each participant for registration and Work Bond.**
- **Please make checks out to either Fast Break Basketball or FBBA.**

Refund policy:

For the **Sr. Division**, if your child drops out of the program before October 1st, 2010 you will receive a refund less a \$20.00 per child administration fee. From October 1st, 2010 there will be no refunds. For the **Jr. Division**, if your child drops out of the program before November 1st, 2010 you will receive a refund less a \$20.00 per child administration fee. From November 1st, 2010 there will be no refunds. All refund requests must be in writing, using our refund request form. The refund form is located on the bulletin board section of the website. **Verbal or e-mailed refund requests will not be accepted.**

Schedules:

The program will be played **Saturday, Sunday and/or weekday evenings**. The day of the week, time, and location can change from session to session, and *when it was played in the previous basketball year*. **It is therefore impossible to inform you as to when your child will be playing until the season begins.** We understand that from time to time your child may have to miss certain dates due to conflicts. Since we are **unable** to give you this information prior to our refund dates, it is imperative that you are flexible as to our schedules. If you are not available 7 days a week, please look into other programs.

Team Selections:

Teams will be put together with a BLIND draft. We do not permit any trades for any reason. In order to properly balance the teams, we use Coach Evaluations and/or player assessment days. We will notify you of these dates, if we find a need for them.

Special Requests:

We will **NOT** honor any special requests. **NO EXCEPTIONS**. We have about 1200 players in our program and it would be impossible to honor all their requests, so we choose to honor **NO** requests. This is for team selection, rescheduling of regular season and playoff games, Travel or AAU tryouts, etc.

End of Season Awards:

Participation trophies will be given in Grades 2 thru 5 ONLY for Co-ed and Girls Divisions. In Grades 6 thru 12, the playoff Champion and Runner-up will be given an award.

Travel:

If you are interested in travel, please refer to the bulletin board section of our web page, and check the box for travel on the application, **in addition** to the recreation program that you are signing your child up for, either co-ed or girls only. **REGISTRATION IS FOR FBBA'S RECREATION PROGRAM. ALL REGISTERED PARTICIPANTS, IF QUALIFIED EITHER BY AGE OR RESIDENCY RESTRICTION WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO TRYOUT FOR TRAVEL.** If you make the travel team you are trying out for, your recreation application fee will be credited to your travel costs. Travel costs are substantially higher than recreation costs. Only East Brunswick residents are eligible for the travel program. If you do not make the travel team, you will either be placed in the coed recreation or girls program, or on the waiting list, depending upon your ticket number.

Registration Packet:

I have read the entire Registration Packet. My signature on the registration form is my acceptance of ALL Fast Break Basketball's Rules.

Refund policy:

For the Sr. Division, if your child drops out of the program before October 1st, 2010 you will receive a refund less a \$20.00 per child administration fee. After October 1st, 2010, there will be no refunds. For the Jr. Division, if your child drops out of the program before November 1st, 2010 you will receive a refund less a \$20.00 per child administration fee. After November 1st, 2010, there will be no refunds. **All refund requests must be in writing.** The refund form is located on the On-Line Forms link of the website. **Verbal refund requests will not be accepted.** Only exceptions for medical reasons (note from a medical doctor required for the player only) will be considered for refunds until November 30th.

Schedules:

The program will be played **Saturday, Sunday and/or weekday evenings**. The day of the week, time, and location will change from session to session, and can be different from the previous year. **It is therefore impossible to inform you as to when your child will be playing until the season begins.** We understand that from time to time your child may have to miss certain dates due to conflicts. Since we are unable to give you this information prior to our refund dates, it is imperative that you are flexible as to our schedules.

Travel:

Fast Break Basketball only accepts registration applications for the Recreational Program. **NOBODY** Registers for Travel. All Recreational Registered Participants (including those on the wait list) are eligible to tryout for the Travel Program (provided that you are an East Brunswick Resident, and meet the age requirements). If you make the travel team, your registration fee will be applied to your travel costs (travel has additional fees). If you do not make the travel team you are trying out for, you will either be placed in the recreational program or on the wait list, depending upon your ticket number. If you decide that you don't want to play in the recreational program, you must send in the refund request form (see refund policy), and are subject to the refund policy rules and guidelines. Nobody is permitted to play both Fast Break Travel & Rec.

Special requests:

We will **NOT** honor any special requests. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** We have approximately 1200 players in our program and it would be impossible to honor all their requests, so we choose to honor **NO** requests. This is for team selection, rescheduling of regular season and playoff games, practice during the playoffs, switching the scheduled trophy days, Travel or AAU tryouts, etc.

Wait List:

Unfortunately we can not accommodate all the children that want to participate in our program. There simply are not enough Basketball Courts, Coaches, and Game Coordinators available to us. All participants on the wait list will be added into the program as spots become available. You will receive a phone call from your VP or Division Director to inquire if you are still interested in having your child participate in the program. *The latest a player can be added to a team is December 21st.* If you are on the wait list and wish to drop out prior to December 21st, you must fill out the refund form (see refund policy) and your uncashed check will be mailed back to you. If you remain on the wait list until the cut-off date and your child does not get added to the program, your uncashed check will be returned to you.

Size of Each Grade Program/Volunteers:

Besides the amount of Basketball Courts available to us, the greatest factor in deciding the size of the program is the volunteers that we have. In order to run a program, **we need two Coaches per team, and two Game Coordinators per grade.** We will not expand a program without the Volunteer commitment. If you don't volunteer at registration, you are taking a risk that your child will not be able to participate. We will not start chasing down volunteers to expand the program.

Game Coordinators (for grades 4 and up):

The East Brunswick Township and Schools require Fast Break Basketball to have someone (we call them Game Coordinators) at each of our game sites. In the event that a particular grade does not have **at least two Game Coordinators, games will NOT be played** – practice sessions only. Please refer to the job description of a Game Coordinator in the Volunteer Information section of the website.
